Task 1: Trim Painting. (Medium priority)

Your group would gather materials and tools to paint metal doors and interior trim.

Items needed would be drop cloths, painters tape, sand paper and /or sanding blocks, trim brushes, rags and paint (be sure to check for correct color to use. Church can provide if cost is a concern).

Details of work: Place and tape drop cloth in place. Tape appropriate surroundings, sand metal doors and metal trim. Apply one coat of trim paint. Let Dry. Lightly sand. Apply second coat. If brush strokes are still visible, a third coat may be needed. Some skill is needed since these are high visibility areas. Report back your progress.

Task 2: Seeding: (High Priority)

Your group would gather tools and equipment needed to place seed on areas that have no grass growing. (This job must be down for county inspection on 6/13).

Equipment needed would be shovels, wheelbarrows, rakes, gloves, dust masks

Details of work: Spread seed on dirt areas only. About a handful to 5 sqft. Then take the top soil/compost mix and spread ½" over the seed. Then spread 1-2" of straw over the top soil. Water until straw is wet and matted down.

Task 3: Trimming Bushes and Trees.

Your group would be asked to trim and clean up excessive growth and fence lines on the main campus and in the cemetery.

Equipment needed: Hedge trimmers, various saws, gloves, eye protection, truck or trailer, possible chain saw.

Detail of work: Mostly grunt work. Clipping and sawing and you will be given instructions on what to do and what to trim back. We are not able to dispose on site any more and the branches and brush will need to haul up the road.

Task 4: Cleaning:

Scrub the youth center/ parsonage and/or main building from top to bottom.

Equipment needed: Rags, mild cleaners, swiffers and dusters, furniture polish, glass cleaner, vacuums, scrub brushes. Some things on hand, but the extras will help.

Mostly wiping walls and baseboards. Dusting, general cleaning. Needs to be done every 30-60 days. Any Saturday or Monday, there is general cleaning to be done. If a group shows up, it allows for other repairs to be done.

Task 5: Install bookshelf system on wall in the pastor's office.

Equipment needed: Drills, screwdrivers, stud finders, tape measure, hammer, saw,

Details of work would be to anchor a shelf strip on a stud with 3" screws and place boards on shelf. Any help moving books would be appreciated as well.

Task 6: Strip and wax floors

Call for details. Very physical work and would need to have some experience or be willing to learn.

Task 7: Moving furniture

Equipment needed would be truck, trailer, and dolly if available.

Details would include moving sofas and other items to different rooms and taking 10+ pieces to LOVE Inc, Salvation Army or the dump.

Task 8: Pulling Weeds

In all islands and mulch beds and in the cemetery.

Haul away needed on all the large loads.

The Cemetery is a ideal project for a Life Group to take on as their special project to maintain for 6 months or a year.
